Sheikh Zayed Mosque visit with the architect:

Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque is located in Abu Dhabi, the capital city of the United Arab Emirates,[1] and is considered to be the key site for worship in the country.

Gallerie one Visit:

Enjoying a splendid location, Gallery One is a landmark cultural venue in Abu Dhabi. The gallery has previously hosted the works of acclaimed artists such as Wissam Shawkatt, Helen Abbas, Tariq Dajani, James Dominé, Khalid Shaheen and Paul Sheldon – but also exhibitions focusing particularly on art from the region, such as The Arts of Islam: Treasures of the Nasser D. Khalili Collection. Although the concept of the gallery and its vision of ‘democratising art’ are evolving into a more global brand, its origins are firmly rooted in the UAE as the first Gallery One opened in Dubai in 2006.

Lunch at Li Beirut at Jumeirah Etihad Towers (direct payment):

Li Beirut's vision is to revolutionise Arabic cuisine in Abu Dhabi, and the ambition is on show in every dish. From the foie gras kebbeh starter to the signature main course of zaatar crusted rack of lamb accompanied by sweet potato and truffle, in addition to scrumptious traditional favourites, everything on the menu is a masterpiece.

Afternoon N2N Gallery visit:

A newcomer to Abu Dhabi's art scene, N2N has been bringing inspiring art collections from Europe to the UAE and Abu Dhabi since May 2013. Founded by two Ukrainian expats, Natalya Muzaleva and Natalia Petrukha, the gallery blends sculpture, graphic art and paintings in a surprising fusion between realism and modernism. For the very first time in Abu Dhabi, more than 170 works by 13 different artists are on display. Among the artists the gallery represents are established Ukrainian artists like Petro Bevza, Igor Shipilin, Ramazan Useinov, Katerina Kosianenko, as well as the French artist Christian Jequel and the famous Spanish pastel master Cesar Estrany. The N2N Gallery has also recently introduced the young Ivorian artist, Turay Mederic, to UAE art enthusiasts. Additionally, the gallery organizes art master classes, inviting famous artists to teach UAE residents and is committed to support the development of the local art scene in Abu Dhabi.



Opera Gallery visit:

The Dubai branch of the Opera Gallery family (they have premises everywhere from New York to Miami, London, Paris, Geneva and Seoul) is just as impressive as its capital counterparts. They regularly showcase some of the most expensive (we're talking multimillion Dirham) auctions in Dubai – with works from the likes of Botero, Chagall and Matisse currently on show. Granted, you may not be able to find the loose change for those kind of purchases down the back of the sofa, but you can make the most of their presence in DIFC and go and see them for free. Now that's what we call a steal.

The Empty Quarter visit:

Also in DIFC (in case you couldn't tell, this is one of the main art hubs of Dubai – might have something to do with the wages of the people that work there...) you will find The Empty Quarter. Co-founded by Saudi Arabian Princess HRH Reem Al-Faisal and Emirati Safa Al-Hamed, it is the only fine art photography gallery in the city, and regularly showcases work from some of the world's greatest photographers, such as Steve McCurry, Bruno Barbey, Marc Riboud, and Al-Moutasim Al Maskery. If you or your mates are keen snappers, this is the place to geek out and learn a thing or two about lighting.

Salsali Private Museum Visit :

The Salsali Private Museum (SPM), in Dubai, United Arab Emirates, is the first private museum in the region for contemporary Middle Eastern and international art. It was founded in November 2011 by Ramin Salsali, and is located in the industrial area of Al Quoz in Alserkal Avenue, a warehouse complex with the highest concentration of galleries and creative spaces in the region.
